


Outdoor etiquette



The community duty

Your Responsibilities. Travel with care to local inhabitants and show consideration to our way of life. Respect private property and public spaces such as schools and graveyards.

Stay on the trail

Avoid establishing new trails. Walk as little as possible on worn trails during wet periods.

Use established toilets

If there is no toilet nearby, you can dig a hole in the ground and take the paper back to a waste bin.

4



Take all waste with you.

Always take your waste with you and only throw it in public waste bins.

5



Respect wildlife and birds

Be kind and give space to animals and birds. Remember to keep dogs on a leash.

6



Sustainable choices

Leave no trace behind in nature. You are responsible for your own safety – choose trips according to your own abilities.

7



Be considerate in traffic

The roads in Senja are narrow, and there are many users. Park in designated spaces. Be aware of cyclists!

8



Use existing campfire sites

During the summer months, there is a general ban on campfires and the use of open fire.

9



Use designated areas for camping

Camping is not allowed closer than 150 meters from homes or cabins, and inland field camping requires landowner permission.
